



Houston Skyline Facility Protocols 2020-2021

Updated 12/30/20

Spectators:

- We will only be allowing two spectators per athlete. This is to keep our gym within the allowable limit for building capacity (75%) to keep everyone as safe as possible.
- PLEASE REMAIN HOME IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
 - Contact with any individual who has received a positive COVID-19 test recently.
 - Any of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, fever (above 100.3F), loss of taste or smell, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, diarrhea.
- **Wristbands will be disbursed by team. A representative from each team will pick up an envelope with all team spectator wristbands (max # of 24 adults). Cash only of \$120 or \$5/wristband. Team rep will distribute to team. If you know that your team will have fewer spectators for the day, you can buy the total amount needed and the rest will be sold on a first come first serve basis. There is NO GUARANTEE wristbands will be available if you do not secure through your team.**

Entrance:

- Masks are **required** for everyone entering the facility. Masks are required to be worn by all athletes when not competing in the match. As soon as they are no longer playing or warming up, they will be required to immediately put their mask back on. Coaches will be required to wear masks at all times as well. Please help us in enforcing this policy with your team's spectators as it is really

difficult for us to enforce throughout the day. We will have people roaming on occasion to make sure everyone is following this important policy.

- No outside food or drink will be permitted (only exception is water bottles for coaches and athletes). Weather permitting tailgating will be allowed in the grass field behind the building. DO NOT set up a tailgate in front of the building or on the asphalt parking lot as this will congest the parking lot.



Sanitation/Facility:

- At every referee stand or scorer's table will be a spray bottle of hand sanitizer. At every break in play (timeouts, set end, match end, etc), athletes and coaches will be encouraged to get hand sanitizer from the spray bottles before returning to play. They may also utilize their own sanitizer.
- There will be no water fountains available in the facility to prevent the spread of any germs through that realm. Athletes and coaches are allowed to bring in water bottles.
- There will be no pre/post-match high fives. This will be replaced by hand waving at the attack line instead.
- Contact celebrations (high fives, etc) will need to be limited and monitored as much as possible. The volleyballs will be sterilized via UVC light with our Sterilazer Floor Unit that will be utilized throughout the day. We will have 2 game balls per court.

Concessions:

- We will be running a concession stand. We will require social distancing in our lobby and while in line at the concession stand. We encourage spreading out while eating and drinking.
